Growing up in Detroit the oldest of seven children, Bil was enthralled with the harp—its rich, soothing sound and its stylish players. But her own musical aspirations would have to wait.

After moving to Tacoma in 1951, Bil became active in politics and public service. She was the first executive director for Planned Parenthood in Pierce County. She served as special assistant to the County Executive, was elected to the Tacoma City Council in 1999, and served as Deputy Mayor. She led the fight against housing discrimination as a board member of the NAACP and served on the TPU board for a decade.

When Bil finally retired, she resolved to grow roses—and learn to play the harp. Her teacher was Pat Wooster, a Symphony Tacoma musician and now her colleague on the Board.
